Application form required. Applicants should submit the

- 1) name, address and phone number of organization
- 2) listing of board of directors, trustees, officers and other key people and their affiliations
- 3) contact person
- 4) copy of IRS Determination Letter
- 5) detailed description of project and amount of funding requested
- 6) explanation of why grantmaker is considered an appropriate donor for project
- 7) plans for cooperation with other organizations, if any
- 8) copy of current year's organizational budget and/or project budget
- 9) geographic area to be served
- 10) population served
- 11) listing of additional sources and amount of support
- 12) how project will be sustained once grantmaker support is completed
- 13) results expected from proposed grant
- 14) what distinguishes project from others in its field
- 15) how project's results will be evaluated or measured
- 16) signature and title of chief executive officer
- 17) copy of most recent annual report/audited financial statement/990
- 18) principal source of support for project in the past
- 19) additional materials/documentation
