

Section 317 Immunization Funding History

Landing for the Section 317 Immunization Program at the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention has remained the same for vaccine operations and infrastructure over the last several years. Funding for vaccine purchase has decreased. Fifty-three percent of the

funding now comes from the Prevention and Public Health Fund. Sufficient funding for health departments must be provided to maintain critical immunization programs and outbreak response and control.
