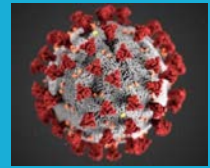

Version 2.0 – Summary of Updates

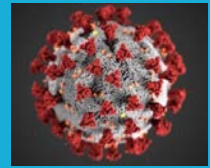
- Clarified prescriber licensure verification

- Added information on **v-safe**

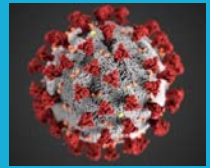
