

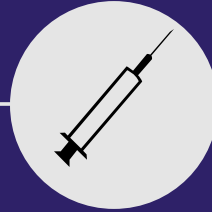

## How does the program work?

Harm Reduction Programs provide anonymous access to testing, counseling, treatment and other services. The goal of the syringe exchange component is to reduce the risk of contracting HIV, viral hepatitis and other blood borne infections by encouraging the use of sterile syringes for each injection.
