Timeline

- January 5, 2024
 - Request for applications opened
- January 11, 2024
 - Informational webinar
- January 26, 2024
 - Applications due
- February 16, 2024
 - Anticipated award notification
- June 30, 2024
 - Project period ends & all reimbursements due



Eligibility criteria

- The application is open to local health departments.
- The application is on OpenWater and can be accessed through the announcement page.
- Each LHD will appoint one POC, responsibilities include:
 - Liase with NACCHO
 - Manage award acceptance, reimbursements, & submit application
 - Coordinate LHD staff taking CIC or a-IPC exams



Application Overview

- Contact info for each individual planning to be certified & their eligibility
- · Details of the course, training, or materials you plan to buy
- Short response demonstrating:
 - Need, capacity, and impact of certification on your LHD and the community
 - How this opportunity will benefit your current infection control activities
 - Plans or considerations for sustainability



Funding specifics

- Selected LHDs will be reimbursed for staff exam fees and materials
- Exam registration is required
- Award amount: \$2,500-\$5,000
- What is reimbursable?
- Reimbursements can be submitted at any time until June 30, 2024 (the project period end date). **Each LHD will submit only one reimbursement request.**
 - What if my health department has purchasing restrictions or challenges with this process and it will be an individual who is covering the upfront expenses?

Exam Tips & Recommendations

- Take **TIME** to study! 6 months was recommended
- Work with employer to try to designate study time
- Join or create a study group, pace yourself

- CIC is focused on hospital IPC rather than LHD Epis
- Leverage partners shadow IP, ask state as they may have resources/webinars, study groups, etc.
- Focus on core concepts and applications
- Be confident, it's worth it!
