

# **Member Engagement Pyramid Activity**

# **Action Step: Discuss Roles and Responsibilities**

#### **Overview**

Ensure consistent and ongoing recruitment and engagement of members. This resource introduces members to the Theory of Engagement and depicts multiple levels of engagement through the Member Engagement Pyramid. Use it to assess where your current membership stands, identify gaps in engagement levels, and determine actionable steps to reduce membership gaps.

## **Purpose**

Present the "Theory of Engagement" to the public health and safety team to increase their understanding of what it means to be a team member.

#### When to Use This Resource

Use this resource to gain a better understanding of the Theory of Engagement so members can see the big picture of their team's membership but also understand their own place within the team.

# **Activity Details**



### Who to Involve

This is a judgement call that should be made by the public health and safety leadership team:

- Public health and safety leadership team, at a minimum
- Subcommittee/working group chairs
- Critical agency/community partners
- Members who have a reasonable, working knowledge of the work of the public health and safety partnership, its goals, and needs





## **Time Needed to Complete**

This activity will take 60–180 minutes to complete, depending on several factors:

- The number of names included in the analysis
- If the group decides to complete the activity with a whole public health and safety partnership or in a smaller committee format
- If the partnership decides to complete step 3 or stop at step 2

It is recommended to break into two sessions, completing steps 1 and 2 in the first session and step 3 in the second session
