Cannabis

Arizona	Proposition 205 Legalize Marijuana	Failed
Arkansas	Legalizing medical marijuana for 17 qualifying conditions, creating a Medical Marijuana Commission, and allocating tax revenue to technical institutes, vocational schools, workforce training, and the General Fund.	Passed
California	Legalizing recreational marijuana for persons aged 21 years or older under state law and establishing certain sales and cultivation taxes.	Passed
Florida	Legalizing medical marijuana for individuals with specific debilitating diseases or comparable debilitating conditions as determined by a licensed state physician.	Passed
Maine	Marijuana legalization measure for adults over the age of 21	Likely Passed (99% reporting)
Massachusetts	Legalize marijuana but regulate it in ways similar to alcoholic beverages.	Passed
Montana	Repealing the three-patient limit for medical marijuana providers.	Passed
Nevada	Legalizing the recreational use of one ounce or less of marijuana by individuals 21 years of age and over.	Passed
North Dakota	Legalizing the use of medical marijuana to treat defined debilitating medical conditions, such as cancer, AIDS, hepatitis C, ALS, glaucoma, and epilepsy, and developing certain procedures for regulating medical marijuana growing, dispensing, and usage.	Passed

Tobacco:

State	Issue	Pass/Fail
California	Tobacco tax increase by \$2.00 per pack, with equivalent increases on other tobacco products and electronic cigarettes	Passed
Colorado	Tobacco tax increase by \$1.75 per pack of 20	Failed
Missouri	Tobacco tax increase from 17 cents to 77 cents by 2020 and impose an additional fee on tobacco wholesalers at an initial rate of 67 cents per pack	Failed
Missouri	Tobacco tax increase by 23 cents per pack by 2021 and to add an additional 5 percent sales tax for other tobacco products	Failed
North Dakota	Tobacco tax increase and use the generated tax revenue to fund veteran services and health services	Failed

Colorado	Creation of ColoradoCare, a healthcare payment system designed to finance universal healthcare for Colorado residents partly through an additional 10 percent payroll tax—two thirds paid by employers and one third by employees—providing approximately \$25 billion per year in revenue	Failed
Nevada	Exemption from sales and use tax durable medical equipment, oxygen delivery equipment, and mobility enhancing equipment prescribed for human use by a licensed health care provider	Passed
