



Project Overview

Objective: Provide support for performance and community health improvement topics to local public health departments (LHDs) through statewide public health associations

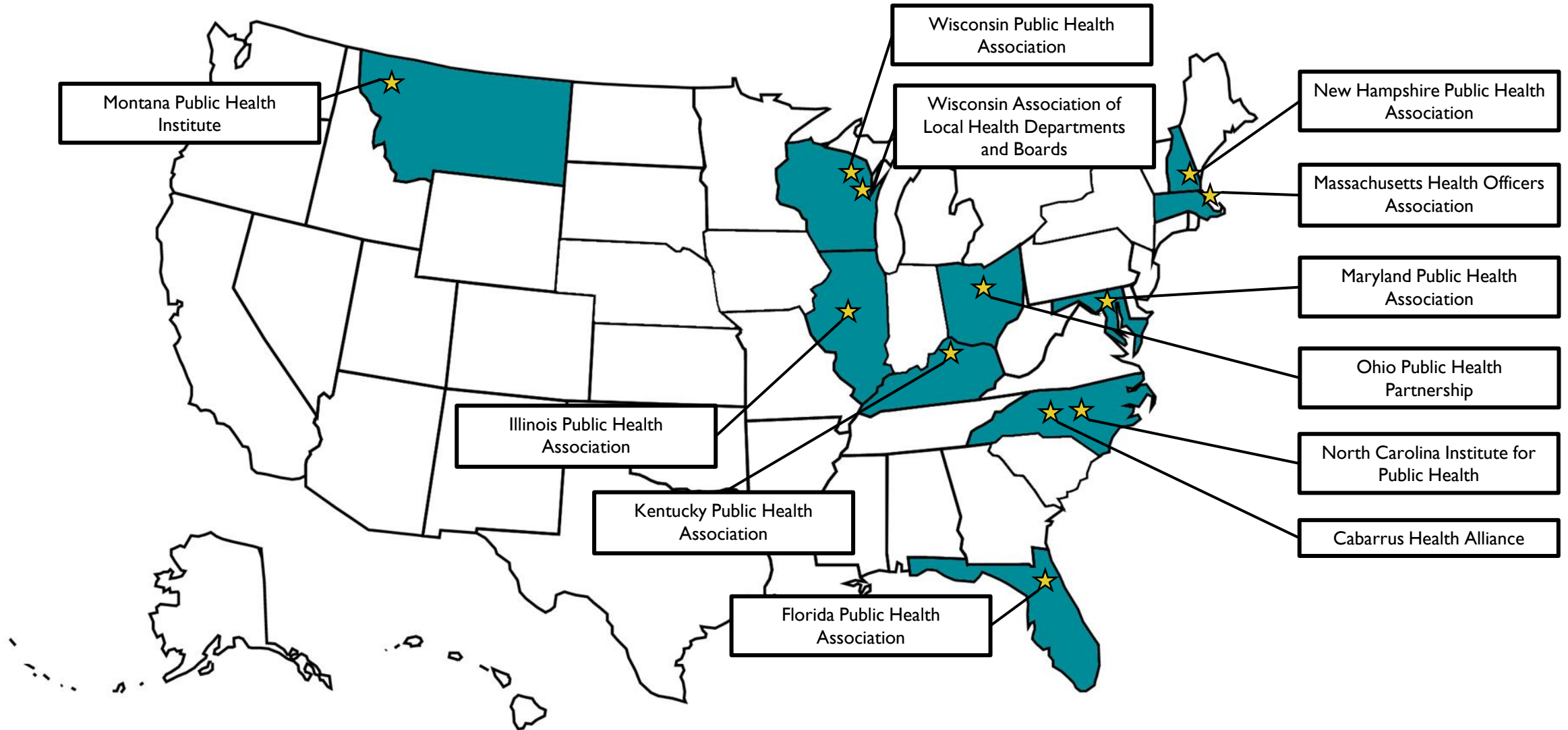
Purpose: Advance the ability and role of statewide associations to support LHDs, particularly in efforts to build health department internal and external infrastructure, and systems and performance improvement capacity.

Support Provided

There is **flexibility** in what this opportunity can support:

1. ***Consultation and Guidance*** – Provision of consultation or guidance on initial ideas to engage LHDs through training or technical assistance (T/TA)
2. ***Connections to Resources*** – Connections to national level resources, speakers, partners, or strategies to enhance T/TA to LHDs
3. ***Direct Funding Award*** – Direct award of up to \$5000 for fully developed proposals to deliver T/TA to LHDs on performance improvement topic areas

Year One Grantees



Examples of Year One Requests

- Webinar series on quality improvement, recruitment and retention, and health equity
- Training needs assessment of the local public health workforce
- Design thinking workshop to increase the quality improvement capacity of LHDs
- Performance management trainings to LHD staff
- Local public health system orientation toolkit
- Accreditation Learning Community
- Workforce development trainings
- Systems and performance improvement content experts to speak at conferences, forums, and trainings geared toward LHDs
- Determining options for engaging LHDs in community health assessment and improvement planning (CHA/CHIP) processes

Eligibility

- Statewide or state- level associations or organizations that support local health departments which includes, but is not limited to, the following types of organizations:
 - State Associations of County and City Health Officials (SACCHOs)
 - State Public Health Associations
 - State Associations of Local Boards of Health
 - Public Health Institutes

Application Submission

- Requests must be submitted via the online platform
- Required sections include:
 - Requesting agency information
 - Describe the mission of your organization and its role in supporting LHDs around performance improvement
 - Describe your request for support
 - Contract documents

- Vendor Information Form
- Certification of Non-Debarment Form
- W-9 Tax Form
- Proof of Active DUNS Number
- Proof of Registration with SAM.gov

Additional Optional Information

- Details of your request/proposed activities
 - Speaker or Trainer
 - Target Audience
 - Needs of LHDs related to Topic
 - Method of Delivery
 - Additional Information
- Project Budget

Intake Call

- 45 Minute Zoom Meeting
- Review the details of the application with the applicant, highlighting and discussing the following components
 - Agency Information and Background
 - Training Topic and Need
 - Training Details
 - Evaluation
 - Additional Information

T/TA Implementation

NACCHO will work with the state association to finalize a scope of work for their T/TA implementation

Delivery format for T/TA in Year One included the following:

- Virtual Trainings
- One-on-One Coaching
- Needs Assessments
- Webinar Series
- Virtual Workshops
- Focus Groups
- Surveys
- Resource Guides and Toolkits
- Virtual Conferences

All T/TA activities **MUST** be **COMPLETELY** implemented no later than July 31, 2022 (end of the project year)

Evaluation Support

Outtake Call

- Determining the impact and effectiveness of:
 - The T/TA provided to LHDs
 - The T/TA request model developed through this initiative

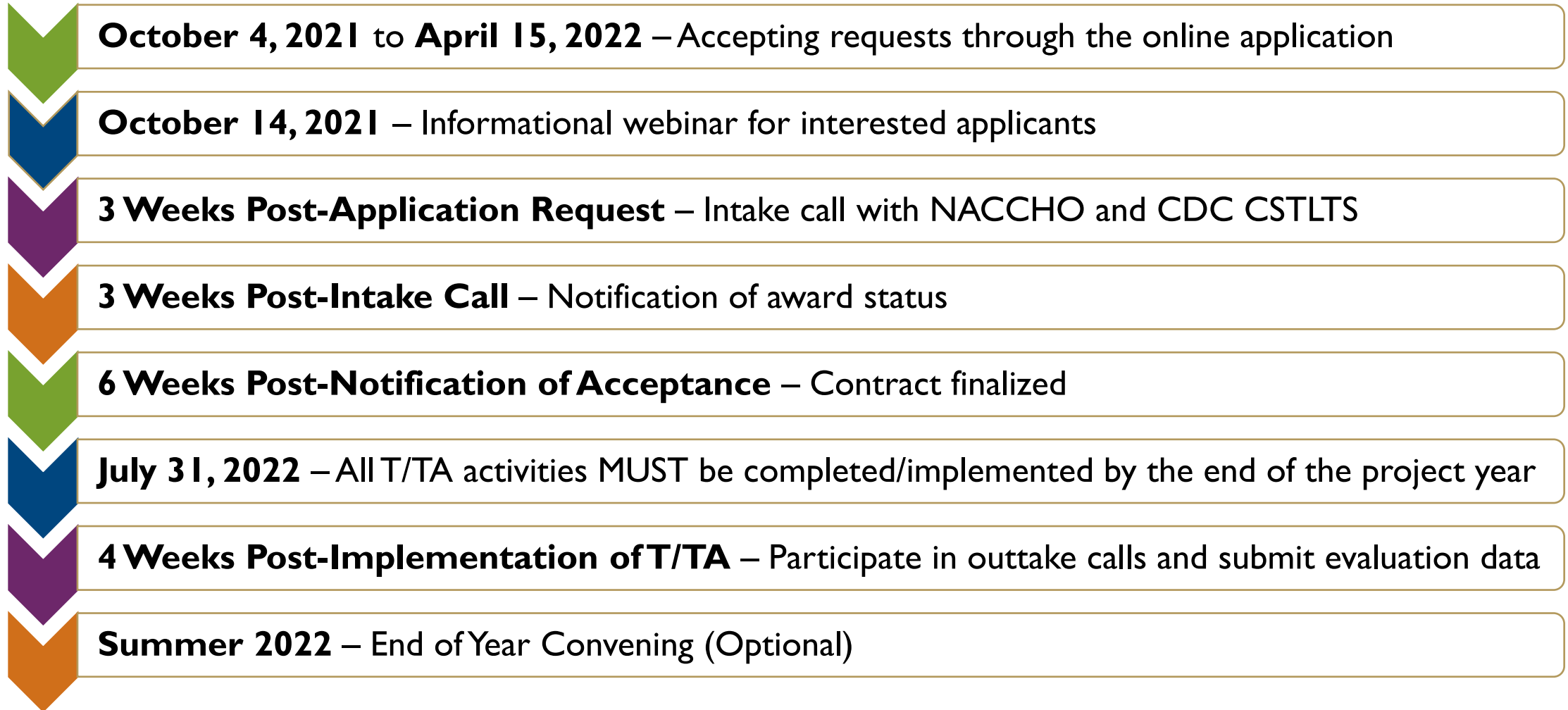
Evaluation Data

- All state associations should conduct a post-T/TA evaluation for all those who participated in their T/TA
- NACCHO will provide all state associations with three Likert scale questions and two open-ended questions that we **recommend** sites include in their post-T/TA evaluation

End of Year Convening

- Optional convening open to all statewide organizations that received funding during the second year of this project
- Opportunity for statewide organizations to:
 - Share insights on topic areas that were covered with LHDs
 - Share best practices for providing T/TA on performance improvement topics
 - Learn about what sites were funded and the T/TA projects that were implemented through these sites
 - Provide additional feedback on the opportunity
