

PPE	Purpose	How to Wear
Facemasks	Protection for nose and mouth.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Facemasks should fit snugly and fully cover the nose and mouth.
Goggles	Protection for eyes.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Goggles should fit snugly over and around the eyes.
Face Shield	Protection to eyes, nose, mouth, and skin.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Face shield should cover the forehead, extend below the chin, and wrap around the side of the face.● An alternative to goggles if extensive splash or spray is anticipated.

Precautions	When to Use	Required PPE
Standard Precautions	All residents	Depending on anticipated exposure: gloves, gown, facemask or eye protection
Droplet Precautions	Pathogens transmitted via respiratory droplets	Gloves, goggles, facemask, faceshield
Airborne Precautions	Pathogens transmitted by the airborne route	Fit-tested N95 or other high level respirator, gloves
Contact Precautions	Pathogens transmitted through direct or indirect contact	Gloves, gown
Enhanced Barrier Precautions	All residents during high-contact activities	Gloves, gown
