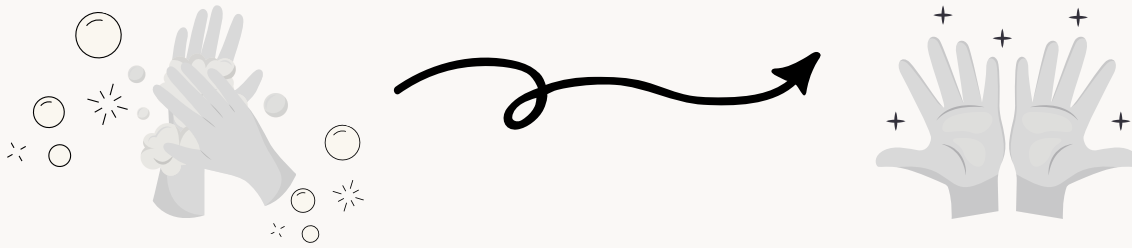
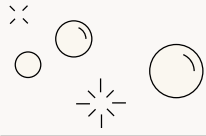


Hand Hygiene Training Activities & Resources
